Curfew for minors-Mayor handed out a section of the Charter 11-704. Curfew for minors It shall be unlawful for any minor, under the age of eighteen (18) years, to be abroad at night between 11:00 P.M. unless going directly to or from a lawful activity or upon a legitimate errand for, or accompanied by a parent, guardian, or other adult person having lawful custody of such minor. (1970 Code, § 10-224) Mayor stated that he had ask that the Police Officers to enforce this.

1. Sarah Spalding ask that a street located in Timberglade Sub- Division be reopened and name Bob Spalding Cove.  
In a previous meeting minutes state that Mr. Bob Spalding came before Council on December 2<sup>nd</sup> 1996 to request that this street be closed because they were having problems with people going down the dead in road and distributing him.
