Communication from Mayor: Mayor Boaz stated that we are proposing that we lower the water rates for residential customers inside the City by \$0.10. This will not affect the minimum bill rate only the amount after the customer uses more than 2,000 gallons. This proposal will also reduce the sewer rate by 8 ½ cents per 1,000 gallons over the 2,000 gallon minimum. Water production costs have been reduced down which makes this possible, City of Decaturville signing up to buy water from us is helping us on our depreciation cost, and this is also helping them by keeping their cost reasonable.
