Mayor Boaz updated the council on the status of various city construction projects:

Phase 4 of the Downtown Enhancement Project is scheduled to be finished by October 27, 2018.

This project is located on Highway 412 West. Phase 5 of the Downtown Enhancement Projects begins at the red light on Highway 412 and Highway 641. The construction authorization for the project is scheduled for July 2019. The Water Treatment Plant improvement project is slightly behind schedule due to weather delays. This project was scheduled to be completed in Mid-October and should be finished not long after that time. The bids for the Phase 2 Community Park project came in considerably over budget. This project consists of two addition ball fields and a pavilion.

The City will modify the plans to lower cost in order to keep it within budget.
