TDOT Multimodal Grant: Still in Environmental, Waiting on 'Notice to Proceed' to submit to TDOT

<u>FEMA Generator Grant</u>: The city received a call from Marsha Blackburn's office. We should anticipate an

award notice by the end of September 2024.

AFG Fire Grant: Grant submitted; waiting on response

SRF Grant: still in design phase

TDEC/ARP: Approved, waiting on SRF Documents

PHMSA Grant (Gas Fund): Grant Submitted, waiting on results

Tennessee Museum Grant: Re-roof replacement on half of City Hall (Cultural Arts section, Community Room

and Council Room). Grant Submitted, waiting on results
